No his first place was near Glenco he bought the
Gales Creek place about 1848

His first name? Henry same as his son

are Geiger, ^I At Smith, ^{II} Naylor, ^{III} Buxton ^{IV}
places all on Gales Creek?

The Geiger place is on the Tualatin about one mile
from the mouth of Gales Creek the other 3 on Gales Creek

Do you think they were all taken
before Ours took his first claim in
1843? (the Forest Grove site)

The Geiger and Smith places were taken about 1840
Naylor place about 1847 Buxton about 1848

Was Ours the first to build
a frame house? after

I do not know

1846

When did he build that
house? Grand pa stayed with Smith winter 1846
lived 1 or 2 years on Geiger place
I suppose he must have built his house near 1849

Was it about 10 rooms
quite good size house must have 8 to 10 rooms
as he had 9 children on arrival and another born in 1849

When did he get a buggy
about 1870 I think
