The Executive Department recently conducted a resource sharing survey. Agency responses identified a broad sharing of equipment, personnel, systems, and space usage. It is apparent there is little reluctance on the part of agency managers and personnel to borrow or share resources.

Many agency personnel requested a survey summary be made available to them. We have attempted to summarize the survey findings in a format for quick reference. This information has long-term reference value. It could also be aligned with the agencies' productivity improvement effort.

The Executive Department does not see the need to establish a formal, centralized resource sharing process, but encourages all agencies to continue the informal sharing currently taking place. However, agency personnel should continue to coordinate with Executive Department personnel when attempting to locate a resource not available to them.

We have not written the institutions in the System of Higher Education. Perhaps you could discuss it with them at your next meeting.
