

POSSIBLE COMMITTEES
FOR NEIGHBORHOOD CENTER BOARDS & CITIZENS

1. General Services:

Review what services are needed in the area. What services are available already to the community? Are they used? If not, why not? How best to bring them to the people, and get the people to know about the services and to use them - such as Health, Dental services, Well Baby and Pre-natal clinics; Family Counseling; Family Planning; Social Security and Medicare information: etc..

2. Education:

How to contact and recruit candidates for Adult Classes - such as G.E.D.; Home Economics; Arts and Crafts; Upward Bound Program; Mental Retardation; Senior Citizens; etc..

3. Employment and Rehabilitation:

Explore the possibilities of Mr. Walt. Jaross' effort in North Plains, its effectiveness: ideas that might help the experiment: how to involve local employers in the effort as well as Job hunters: any local possibilities for training programs: N.Y.C. jobs; M.D.T.A.; O.J.T.; Job Corps; D.V.R.: etc..

4. Recreation:

What kind? Archery; Drama; Dances; Outings; Civic Projects; Horseshoe tournaments; Pincole Club; Senior Citizens; etc..

Any or all of these committees would be Chairmanned by a Board Member, with other Board members involved as desired but with a real effort made to have citizens, who are not now involved, as members of the committees. In this way the local Board would have a broader base of support, better access to more varied ideas as well as more program involvement from their community.

NOTE: The CAP Board of Directors has an active Housing Committee, evaluating County housing needs, reviewing possibility of low cost housing and rentals.
