
Dear Ms. Kirchhoff,

One of the gay community's best friends in Congress urgently needs our help.

Representative Les AuCoin in Oregon is facing a difficult re-election campaign against a well financed candidate.

✓ Rep. AuCoin is a co-sponsor of legislation which would prohibit discrimination in employment and housing based on sexual orientation, even when others in Oregon were backing away. His opponent does not support this legislation.

✓ Rep. AuCoin opposed an amendment which denies gay citizens access to the government's Legal Services program. His opponent responds to the self-righteous zealots in Oregon called "Moral Response."

✓ Rep. AuCoin voted against the Moral Majority's effort which made many sexual acts between consenting adults punishable by prison terms.

For anyone who is committed to individual rights and fair play, Rep. AuCoin's re-election is critical. The margin is tightening and the determining factor may well be which candidate can raise the money to wage an effective campaign.

Rep. AuCoin's re-election is an important priority of the Human Rights Campaign Fund, which helps Congressional candidates who are committed to justice for gay people.
