You and your staff are cordially invited to attend a spectacular multi-image, audio visual presentation on Alaska next Monday, April 30, at 2 and 3 pm in Room 1324 Longworth.

At this time, when crucial decisions about the fate of the Alaska lands are being made, I am very pleased to make this special production available for your viewing.

"South of Denali: Ski Trek in the Alaska Range" is an exciting and professional 25 minute slide show using 6 projectors, 3 screens and stereo music. The show portrays winter in an Alaskan bush cabin beneath towering Denali (Mt. McKinley) and a three week ski touring trek taken last spring by four Oregonians immediately south of Mt. McKinley National Park.

It took place in an area where Sidney Lawrence painted many of his famous Alaska landscapes, and in the immediate vicinity of a major proposed tourist/convention center.

This production features three screen dissolving panoramas which visually depict the incredible scenery for which Alaska is famous. I am certain that it will give you a valuable perspective for better understanding the controversial Alaska issues and I urge you to attend the showing next Monday afternoon at 2 pm. It will be repeated at 3 pm in case you are unable to attend the first showing.
