Scholarships For Pre-Ministerial Students

Pacific University is pleased to announce the establishment of the Jane Brown Haskell Memorial Scholarships to assist outstanding college students expecting to enter the ministry as a life work.

An endowment grant of \$50,000 supporting these scholarships was received in July 1962 by the University from The Windsor Foundation, New York City. The original source of the grant is the estate of the late Frank Haskell of Sharon, Connecticut. The scholarships are named for his wife, the late Jane Brown Haskell.

The value of each scholarship is \$2,000 for the four year college period, provided the recipient maintains a record of high merit.

In addition to the Jane Brown Haskell Memorial Scholarships, Pacific University has a limited number of other scholarships available each year for able students intending to enter the ministry.

Scholarship assistance for non-ministerial students is available to superior candidates. The University also has substantial loan funds to assist worthy students.
