## I. PROTOCOL

- 1. Governor should be addressed as Governor.
- 2. Governor's wife: Mrs. Atiyeh
- 3. Talk only when you are talked to.
- 4. Be familiar with local restaurants and the type and quality of the food.
- 5. Do not smoke or chew tobacco or toothpicks while with the Governor. This includes riding in the vehicle even though the Governor smokes quite heavily.
- Be sure you know the pronunciation of the Governor's name. Basic family info: daughter Susann in Salem and son Tom in Portland.
- 7. Reminder about not consuming alcoholic beverage. You very often will be offered drinks and you will need some tact in refusing them. A good approach is, "I'm sorry, but ['m working."
- 8. Be ready and willing to do whatever the Governor asks. You should have a dollar in change and \$10 in cash in your pocket for emergencies.
- 9. Introduce yourself as Senior Trooper Tom Jones .... thus permitting the Governor to address you in the manner he chooses.
- Be aware of current events and local issues in your area. The Governor will often ask officers, in areas away from Salem, about local issues.

## II. DRIVING

- Be on time, at least 15 minutes prior to the Governor's departure time.
- 2. Have the vehicle clean, including the ash tray.

- 3. When using a department vehicle, empty the trunk. Oftentines an investigator's car has a full trunk with no room for luggage.
- Whenever possible, keep the gas tank full for unforeseeale emergencies.
- 5. The Governor rides in the front passenger seat and prefers to open and close his own door. He also prefers a passenger that he needs to talk with to ride in the left rear seat.

- 6. Strive to get the Governor to his destination on time.
- Know the fastest way to events on schedule. Also be aware of alternate routes.
- 8. When driving on a multi-lane highway, use the lane with the fewest cars. A common mistake is to be stopped at a light in a long line of cars while the lane alongside is almost empty.
- 9. Do not allow other cars to follow the Governor's car. Within reason, speed up or slow down to avoid them. Occasionally someone may spot the Governor and follow out of curiosity.
- 10. When parking the vehicle, strive to keep the passenger side (Governor's) on the curb.

## III. ADVANCE SECURITY

- The Station Commander should make courtesy contacts with law enforcement agencies in the area to be visited and check with them for possible problems.
  - 2. Check with catering manager for potential problems.
  - 3. Know where the Governor will be seated. Check the area and around the podium for anything suspicious.
  - 4. .Be familiar with all exits from the banquet room and the building.
- 5. Make contact with the hotel security when possible.
