JOINT ASSEMBLY IN THE HOUSE
to hear the
State of the State Address
by
Governor Victor Atiyeh

(In the Senate)

PRESIDENT: The Desk Staff and Members of the Senate will assemble in the center aisle and be assisted by the Sergeant at Arms to form a column to march to the House.

(Formation in Senate) Order for column is:

1. Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of the Senate
2. President & President Pro Tempore
3. Senators
4. Desk staff

10:25 a.m. Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of the Senate lead the group in the procession to the House. Column halts as it arrives at the center entrance of the House. The center doors may or may not be open. If not open, Senate Sgt. at Arms raps on the door. After door is opened, or if open, Sgt. at Arms advances and announces to House Sgt. at Arms that the Senate has arrived.

(In the House)
10:30 a.m.

House Sgt. at Arms will be at the center doors. He greets the Senate and addresses the Speaker:

"I have the honor to announce that the Senate has arrived."

Speaker:

The Sergeant at Arms will admit the members of the Senate and staff.

10:35 a.m.

House Sgt. at Arms stands by the center doors and the Secretary of the Senate, Senate Sgt. at Arms and Senators walk down the center aisle in a column of twos, halting at the half-way point.

Speaker:

The Sergeant at Arms of the House will escort the President of the Senate to the Rostrum.

Note: President is escorted to the steps of the Rostrum. The column remains in place while the President is being escorted to the Rostrum.

Speaker: (Greets the President, tenders the gavel.
The President then presides.)

PRESIDENT: The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate will
seat the Senate members.

(Senate Sgt. at Arms proceeds to Rostrum,
faces the Senators and directs them left and
right as the Senate members proceed down the
center aisle filing off by twos with the right
column turning right and the left column
turning left. Chairs are to be provided for
Senators in front of the first row of House
members' desks.)

(Senate Secretary takes a seat on the lower
level of the Rostrum next to the House Chief
Clerk.)

(Senate Desk Staff proceeds to north side of
Chamber for seating.)

(Senate Sgt. at Arms then takes a position at
the desk of the House Sgt. at Arms.)

PRESIDENT:

The Sixty-third Legislative Assembly of Oregon, meeting in Joint Session welcomes you to hear the State of the State address from Governor Victor Atiyeh.

PRESIDENT:

The Secretary of the Senate will call the roll of the Senate.

(Roll Call)

PRESIDENT:

The Chief Clerk of the House will call the roll of the House.

(Roll Call)

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, distinguished guests and members of this Joint Assembly: If there is no objection, Committees to escort our former Governors, State Officials, Judges of the Court of Appeals and the Justices of the Supreme Court and Governor Atiyeh, will be named by the Chair without the formality of motions.

PRESIDENT: There being no objection, so ordered.

(1 Gavel)

PRESIDENT: Representatives Gilmour and Hanneman and Senators Hanlon and Hannon will serve as a Committee to escort the Honorable Mark Hatfield, former Governor of this state, within the bar of the House.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will now appoint Representatives Mc Cracken and Ford and Senators Roberts and Hamby to serve as a Committee to escort the State Elective Officers within the bar of the House.

PRESIDENT: The Chair appoints Representatives Hanlon and Bellamy and Senators Brown and Thorne to serve as a Committee to escort the Chief Judge and the Judges of the Court of Appeals within the bar of the House.

PRESIDENT: The Chair appoints Senators Frye and Cohen and Representatives Springer and Bunn to serve as a Committee to escort the Chief Justice and the Associate Justices of the Supreme Court within the bar of the House.

PRESIDENT: The Chair appoints Representatives Gold and Campbell and Senators Starkovich and Meeker to serve as a Committee to escort the Honorable Victor Atiyeh, Governor of the State of Oregon, within the bar of the House.

PRESIDENT: Please remain seated until the distinguished guests arrive.

(PRELUDE MUSIC)

10:45 a.m. (The escort committees with their Honorable Guests are to enter in the order of precedence indicated by the sequence of their appointment. The first-named of each escort committee is chairperson and will lead the respective groups. When the chairperson reaches an approximate mid-point of the center aisle, the chairperson halts and announces the identification and the arrival of the group per text provided.)

("Honorable Guests" will be assembled in the Governors' Ceremonial Office.
