Dear Mama

After reading your letter that came this morning I thought best to come in and get that 30th as it would have to be mailed today in order to reach you tomorrow.

Just seen your name on back and let the Hospital folks have it. I came round by Ellen's all well. Morgan had been to town, said Pa was feeling poorly yet, but Grandma was much better. Could sit up in bed and seemed quite rational.

I saw Mr Cussick. Said his wife saw you yesterday. This is a day later and than your letter of Tuesday. In case your letter of today does not reach me in the morning I may come to town and see if it is here at P.O. and if not may phone down Sat. 2 o'clock. Of course you can't come to Alene. Perhaps I can find out if you will come alone. I feel quite sure though you will be strong enough to do so by the time

Lessa did not send that part of Dads letter to Ellen about you. Dr Byrd was of the opinion you would get over that numbness. That it was a long time coming on, and would likely go off the same way.

Old man Houston of Knox Butte died yesterday of paralysis, and was buried today at cemetery near Hebrew Cemetery.

This is no doubt my last letter written here in PO on a rough stand. Good by and may you come home to us in safety and in time be fully recovered.
