BOXER.

The "College Spirit" is an old Chinese idol presented to Pacific University in 1898 by J. E. Walker, an alumnus of the class of '67. "Boxer" dwelt in the alcove of Brighton chapel till spirited away by the students. Since he was first seized, he has returned to the alcove but once. That was during the commencement of 1911, when he presided over the alumni program; but he was carried away before anyone in the audience except the present senior class had had an opportunity to see him. That class has kept "Boxer" in concealment, and has allowed him to appear only when well guarded.
