INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM UMATILLA ARMY DEPOT IS THAT THE FATAL AREA REGARDS TO THE NERVE AGENT IS ONE MILE OUTSIDE THE DEPOT AREA, THIS WOULD BE GRID NUMBER 4 ON DOWNWIND DISTANCE MAP. WE HAVE MEN STATIONED AT THE FOLLOWING CONTROL POINTS - POINT NUMBER 1, 6, 7, 9, 13, 2, 4, 10 AND 11. LOCAL CITIZENS HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO REMAIN IN THEIR HOMES AT THIS TIME. THE STANFIELD CITY HALL HAS BEEN SELECTED AS AN ALTERNATE COMMAND POST FOR OREGON STATE POLICE IF NEEDED. TWO SQUADS FROM PENDLETON ENROUTE TO STANFIELD CITY HALL. ONE OREGON STATE POLICE VEHICLE AND HWY DEPARTMENT HAS ARRIVED AT THE ACCIDENT SCENE APPROX ONE AND ONE HALF MILE EAST OF HWY 207 ON TON.
