RE: Details of the 1981 Presidential Inaugural Events

The following information will hopefully fill you in on questions you may be having regarding your inaugural trip. If it does not, please call me at 378-3111.

You are attending the Presidential Inaugural as the special guest of Governor Atiyeh. Each Governor had an allotment of ten couples he could take to the inauguration.

Lodging: I have not received an official confirmation of your reservations. When I spoke with Pat von Borsig on Friday (1/9) about them she said they were to be mailed Friday or Saturday. We agreed if none were received by this coming Wednesday, I would contact her and immediate action would be taken. The Governor and Mrs. Atiyeh plus their guests will be staying at the Washington Sheraton except Marsha and Alan Director who will be staying at the home of Mr. & Mrs. George Joseph, 7601 Rosdhu Ct. in Chevy Chase, MD (301-652-2465).

Tickets: At the present time, no tickets have been received for the events but they should arrive soon. According to the Inaugural Committee computer run they have been sent out. If they do not arrive by Wednesday, I will be in touch with Terry of the ticket committee to arrange 'will call' pick up for you.

For the Governors Reception on Sunday, January 18, I received word that each Governor is entitled to have eight people in his booth with him and that you would receive (along with your tickets which designate the shift you are to attend) a pass to enter the booth. Guess we will have to play that by ear but don't be surprised if this does occur. Should be lots of fun to be with your Governor in the booth!

Your tickets to attend the Inauguration Ceremony at the White House (standing only) are the compliments of Senator Hatfield and it is necessary for you to pick them up from Jim Hemphill in Sen. Hatfield's Office at 463 Russell Senate

Office Building (202-224-8315) which is across the street from the Capitol Building at the corner of First Street & Constitution Avenue N.E. on Monday, January 19 between 9:30 a.m. and 5:00~p.m.

Transportation: May be difficult although I have been assured there will be ample taxicab coverage. A tip from a frequent visitor to D.C. -- if you have trouble flagging down a cab go to a nearby hotel and have the doorman get one for you while you wait in the lobby out of the cold, cabs seem to congregate ta the hotels.

The Governor & Mrs. Atiyeh have a car, driver and military aide assigned to them. As you can see by their tight schedule that courtesy is definitely necessary.

Clothing: Dress warm!! I'm told hats, gloves and long johns are important --french long johns for the ladies! Dress is indicated in parenthesis on the schedule. Oregon's Governor will wear black tie whenever imperative but not white tie!
