## JOINT ASSEMBLY IN THE HOUSE

## (In the Senate)

"The desk staff and members of the Senate will assemble in the center aisle and be assisted by the Sergeant at Arms to form a column of two's with the Senate staff leading and followed by the Senators the President last."

Order for formation is:

1. Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of Senate 2. Desk staff
2. Senators -- the President last.

Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of Senate lead the column to the House. Column halts as it arrives at the center entrance of the House. The center doors may or may not be open. If not open, the Senate Sgt. at Arms raps on the door. After doors are opened by llouse Sgt. at Arms, the Senate Sgt. at Arms anrounces arrival of Senate.
(In the Hoisc) Housc Sgt. at Arms will be at the center doors facing the Senate; he turns about and addresses the Speaker:

"The Sergeant at Arins will admit the members of the Senate ancl staff."

House Sgt. at Arms stands aside by the center doors and the Secretary of the Senate, Senate Sgt. at Arms, Staff, and Senators proceed down the center aisle in a column of two's. They halt near the midway point, turn to face each other providing a passage way between the column of two's. (President is at the end of the line.)
