May 23, 1968

I wrote a letter of protest to Oregon Journal about inefficiency at Medical school and got Hugh's OK to send it. I didn't mention CAP, but sent an additional letter asking the Journal to consider having Marge Davenport do an investigation from a patients point of view.

Mrs. Moon came for TOPS club. I showed her notes I took at Titkin's talk on Motivation. She hasn't received her tutoring material yet, for Herschell Holmes.

I spent a little time cleaning up center as Jerry is still in jail.

I went to seminar on Migrants--excellent. Got some concrete answers for criticism of migrants.

I went to VML and copied scores of our kids on their grade level tests taken at beginning of class and discussed these with Mrs. Bass. Nancy Hierle passed GED test with flying colors.

I called Evelyn Crook and gave her names of Amarante Lucero and Denorah Hargie, whom she knows. She may help these people.

I attended preliminary hearing in court for Roger and Jim Dozier and Jones boy from 3 to 5. Although girl's testimony was weak, the fact that she is under 16 makes it rape. They now have option of a trial, but atty probably wont request it as he didn't think it would help a lot.

May 24, 1968

Walt Jaross called with job offer for seamstress at home laundry at Hillsboro. Also discussed Jerry Smith and Jim Johnson for jobs and job corps.

Herschell Plummer came and we discussed meeting and migrants. I asked Jerry Smith about cemetery job. Quit. Didn't like it. The golf course job is only temporary. I reported this to employment for their records.

Mrs. Blanche Stewart and Mrs. Reid were not interested in the seamstress job at the laundry.

Slugger and Bill Mc are interested in box boy at Villa Mark, and Jim will handle this.

Alice Riley stopped to discuss migrant meeting too. .

Donna Cameron invited me to visit camps with her. I didn't go as I didn't think it was a good idea, also I had to keep the center open.
