A. Nature and Purpose of the Project:

Develop and implement a program to provide information and referral to social and related community services.

B. Proposed Location or Impact Area(s):

Assistance will be provided for families and individuals seeking access to services in Washington County.

C. Duration/Timing of the Project:

July 1, 1997 to June 30, 2000

D. Number of Low and Moderate Income or Target Group Beneficiaries:

32,450 calls a year from individuals living in income qualified households.

E. Component Activities (CDBG vs. Others):

CDBG = \$92,889 Other = \$114,297

F. Quantitative Projections for CDBG Component Activities:

The project will provide information and referral services to low income residents so that they are better able to effectively access community services. The project will upgrade the existing information and referral system to improve services, and these products will be available to the public. primarily, referrals will be made in the area of social, health and legal services, employment, education and crisis intervention. CDBG funds will support the direct service provision. United Way, Community Service Block Grant and Agency in-kind contributions will support project management and systems development.
