BACKGROUND: Seiko Epson Corporation was the last of three majorJapanese investment announcements in Oregon during 1984. Their's was also the smallest investment. Epson has been reported in Japanese press as saying that the plant in Oregon will start with printer production but will eventually produce personal computers and be their world-wide centerfor research and development. Concerns have arisen lately regarding the slowdown of demand for dot-matrix printers and how this might affect the start-up of the Oregon facility. During the past year, it is widely known, but not confirmed by S-E, that IBM cancelled a large contract for the supply of printers on an OEM basis. The reason for the cancellation was that IBM had designed its own printer, the ProPrinter, which is acknowledged to be superior to all of the Japanese competition in its price range - in itself, a shock to the local manufacturers. Also during the past year, Epson made several important internal decisions which culminated in the production and bringing to market of the Equity line of IBM-PC compatable personal computers. This move, and the resulting marketing efforts in the U.S., seems to have given S-E an edge over their Japanese competitors.

BACKGROUND: Mitsubishi Metal had been investigating the possibility of investing in the U.S. for a long period of time. Initially introduced to the JRO through Nomura Securities in Spring, 1985, Mitsubishi Metal's operation in the U.S. would be responsible for the production of polycrystalline ingots. An important feature of this investment case is that while Mitsubishi Metal will supply raw materials to its "sister" company located in North Carolina and would probably be best advised to locate its plant closer to North Carolina, one of the firm's primary customers is Fujitsu Microelectronics. Regardless of location, MMC would have it sister operation in N.C. as a captive customer while close proximity to the Fujitsu operation in the Gresham area is viewed as being critical to maintaining the Fujitsu-MMC relationship. With the delay in construction of the Fujitsu facility now at an end, MMC now has followed Fujitsu's lead acquiring SILTEC in Salem. It has always been known that Oregon was their preferred site due, in part, to the great amount of information compiled by Mitsubishi Electric.
