Enclosed, you'll find sorted summaries for the Group-work session of the Planning Retreat. I've presented them in 2 formats, the first summarizes each department, just as we compiled them in the Brainstorm session. The second, is as a total grouping of the suggested goals, all related to the Strategic Goals. The use of these two formats will let you and your staff make better decisions about how to pursue your Strategic Goals.

Many of the suggestions, even some that recieved high weight, involve what appears to me to be lobbying of some sort. I would remind you to seek the advice of your legal counsel concerning lobbying efforts and your non-profit status.

As I tried to condense this material, I was struck with the incompleteness of the MBO goal development. Many of the Strategic Goals have no operational goals or emphasis in your Department Goals. Since you only have your departments to use in carrying out your objectives, you run the very real possibility of not reaching those Strategic Goals. I would recommend a tightening up of the linkage between your Strategic Goals and your Department Goals. I have some thoughts on how you could best accomplish this.
