The following are a sample of Congressman AuCoin's speeches and floor statements on reproductive rights.

1. June 18, 1981. Statement on an amendment that would prohibit Legal Services attorneys from providing advice relating to abortion to clients. House of Representatives.
2. July 30, 1981. Statement on an amendment that would prohibit abortion to victims of rape who live in the District of Columbia. House of Representatives.
3. July 14, 1982. Statement on the Equal Rights Amendment. House of Representatives.
4. September 22, 1983. Statement on an abortion rider amendment on an appropriations bill. House of Representatives.
5. January 21, 1984. Speech before Oregon NARAL Conference.
6. June 28, 1984. Statement on amendment that prohibits federal employees from using the Federal Employee Health Benefit Program for abortion coverage. House of Representatives.
7. January 24, 1985. Statement on the 12th anniversary of the Supreme Court Decision Roe v. Wade. House of Representatives.
