Aircraft, damaging or destroying c.594

Excused

Prohibits wilfully damaging or destroying any aircraft. Provides penalties. (H 1802)

, watercraft, unauthorized use c.552

A

Adds unauthorized taking or use of watercraft and aircraft to crime of unauthorized use of vehicle. Amends ORS 164.670. (H 1851)

Child abuse, reporting by physicians c.472

A

Extends procedures requiring reports by physicians of physical abuse to children to include wanton neglect. Exempts from liability persons making required reports. Eliminates husband-wife privilege in judicial proceedings on child abuse. Requires Chief Medical Investigator to maintain central files on child abuse cases to be made available to law enforcement agencies. Provides penalties. Amends ORS 146.710, 146.990. Repeals ORS 146.720. (H 1504)

False financial statements c.454

A/SP

Prohibits false representation of financial condition for purposes of procuring services or credit card. Amends ORS 165.615. (S 342)

Jails, damage to prohibited c.453

A

Prohibits damage to county and city jail property. Provides penalties. Amends ORS 164.455. (S 268)

Refrigerators, discarding c.118

A

Prohibits discarding, in a place accessible to children, refrigerator or similar container with door or lid that cannot be opened easily from within. Provides penalties. (H 1337)

Unlawful entry of dwelling, exemption c.450

A

Establishes reasonable belief of lawfulness of entry as defense to charge of unlawful entry. Amends ORS 164.462. (S 217)

Permits court in criminal cases to require care other than institutionalization for mentally retarded defendants. Amends ORS 135.160. (H 1832)

Permits court to release defendant on his own recognizance in lieu of bail. Provides penalties for failure to appear as ordered by court. (S 78)

A

Information, arrest,
preliminary examination c.508

Clarifies definition of "information". Provides procedure for notifying magistrate issuing warrant of arrest of defendant and his posting bail in another county. Requires magistrate to inform defendant of right to preliminary examination and to allow defendant use of telephone to obtain counsel. Revises procedures for subpoenas for preliminary examination. Amends and repeals sections in ORS chapter 133. Amends ORS 140.040. (S 314)

Penalties, fines, inability
of defendant to pay VETOED

Directs court to inform defendant of rights as pauper at time of sentence to pay a fine. Permits court to release pauper defendant upon completion of imprisonment, if any. Repeals and enacts in lieu of ORS 169.160. Vetoed by Governor; will be reconsidered at next legislative session. (S 72)

Establishes fine of \$500 in addition to imprisonment, for felonies not otherwise punishable by fine. (S 406)

Authorizes courts, in sentencing, to use probation officers' presentence investigation reports. Permits courts to furnish reports to defendant's counsel and state. Amends ORS 137.090. (S 311)

A

probation, condition
of jail confinement c.346

Authorizes courts, in criminal cases, to include period of jail confinement as condition of probation. Amends ORS 137.540, 137.550, 169.110. (S 317)

A

Service of subpoena c.418

Permits service of subpoena in criminal case by delivery only and deletes reading requirement. Amends ORS 139.100. (H 1416)

Directs Secretary of State to

Directs State Game Commission to intensify its big-game research program regarding mule deer, including feeding habits, migrations and methods of increasing winter food supplies.

Commercial fishing, law revision c.570 A

Revises laws relating to commercial fishing, eliminating obsolete provisions and changing to reflect modern practices in industry. Adds to and amends and repeals sections in ORS chapters 506, 507, 508, 509, 511, 513. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (S 235)

licenses, boats c.67

Requires annual renewal of commercial fish boat license beginning January 1, 1965. Adds to ORS 508.105 to 508.220. Repeals ORS 508.413. Eff. 9 Mar 65. (S 135, repealed by c. 570, OL 1965, eff. 1 Jan 66)

oyster processors, fees, licenses, reports N c.162

Exempts oysters from licenses and fees under commercial fishing law. Requires processors of oysters to file annual reports with Fish Commission. Eff. 12 Apr 65. (S 10)

poundage fees, abatement A/SP. c.309

Abates poundage fees imposed before August 13, 1965, on food fish and shellfish brought into Oregon after having been landed elsewhere. (H 1453)

Commercial fishing (cont.)

poundage fees, exceptions A/SP. c.310

Excludes from poundage fees food fish or shellfish brought into Oregon if tax or fee has been paid where fish were landed. Redefines terms used in assessing poundage fees. Amends ORS 508.305 and 508.320. (H 1454)

Definitions A c.149

Redefines "This Act" as used in laws relating to fish and game. Amends ORS 496.025. (S 123)

Fishing, licenses, juvenile bait fish A c.103

Permits juveniles under 18 to secure free license for certain bait fish and to sell such fish to wholesale dealers. Adds to ORS 508.105 to 508.135. Eff. 25 Mar 65. (S 9)

licenses, persons in state institutions A c.224

Authorizes issuance of free angling licenses to Board of Control for persons in state institutions. (H 1374)

Fishways at dams and obstructions A c.167

Transfers from State Game Director to State Game Commission duty to examine dams and artificial obstructions on inland streams and, if necessary, to require fishways. Permits commission, prior to construction of new dam, to determine whether passageway is required. Amends ORS 498.730. (S 112)

Game commission, meetings A c.74

Permits meetings to establish fishing and hunting seasons to be at appropriate times, at least once each three months, rather than during stated periods. Requires open meetings. Amends ORS 496.130, 496.190, 496.195, 496.240. (H 1165)

Hunting, Devils Lake area N c.20

Prohibits hunting game or discharging firearms in Devils Lake area, Lincoln County. Excepts peace officers and persons acting in defense of persons or property. Provides penalties. Amends ORS 498.225. (S 50)

Hunting (cont.)

restricted areas, special permits c.72 A

Permits State Game Commission to establish restricted areas and to issue special tags or permits for taking of big game animals or game birds in such areas. Amends ORS 497.510, 497.530, 497.540. (H 1161)

special tags or permits SJR 22 A

Directs the State Game Commission to issue notices to applicants who do not receive special big game tags or permits and to issue tags or permits first to persons receiving rejections five or more consecutive years or, if there are more applicants than authorized tags or permits, to hold a public drawing.

use of aircraft c.507 A/SP.

Requires helicopter pilot to maintain logbook and to fly at 500 feet or over on flights transporting hunters. Adds to ORS chapter 498. Amends ORS 498.050. (S 310)

use of poison, restricted c.73 A

Permits use of poison to kill birds of unprotected species only, and to kill rodents only if poison is least hazardous to protected birds. Amends ORS 498.510. (H 1163)

Hunting and fishing licenses, foreign students c.295 A

Authorizes issuance of resident hunting and fishing licenses and big game tags to foreign exchange students. Abolishes gun license requirement for aliens. Adds to ORS chapter 497. Repeals ORS 497.090. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (H 1212)

Forest Research Laboratory,
advisory committees c.433

Revises list of industry associations that may recommend, to State Board of Higher Education, appointments to advisory committees to Forest Research Laboratory. Amends ORS 526.225. (H 1777)

Forestry Department,
equipment, leasing of c.87

Permits State Forester, with approval of State Board of Forestry, to lease departmental equipment to federal agency engaged in common activity if agency agrees to maintenance and rental fee. Adds to ORS chapter 526. (S 121)

A

, powers and duties c.428

Directs forester to enforce, in forest protection districts, prohibition against rubbish dumping. Sets \$2 minimum fee for forest patrol assessments. Authorizes collection of fire fighting costs from one negligently or wilfully setting it within one-half mile of district boundary. Permits direct billing of forest patrol assessments. Authorizes forester to burn slashing. Changes computation of reserve base for East Side Emergency Fire Cost Fund. Adds to, amends and repeals sections in ORS chapter 477. Eff. 19 Mar 65. (H 1658)

A

Law revision c.253

Revises laws relating to forests, particularly those relating to administration of State Forestry Department and to protection of forests and grazing land from fire. Rearranges and simplifies existing law with minimum of substantive change. Amends and repeals sections in ORS chapters 477, 526 and others. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (H 1439)

Billboards c.219 A

Redefines terms used in statutes regulating outdoor advertising signs along public highways. Permits two immediately adjacent signs to qualify as one sign, but eliminates exemption from spacing requirements for series signs and signs within 300 feet of advertised business. Restates provisions relating to location, spacing, permit fees, removal of nonconforming signs and hearings. Adds to and amends sections in ORS chapter 377. Repeals ORS 377.205. (H 1564)

County market roads, tax apportionment c.512 A

Requires special taxes levied for market roads to be apportioned same as general road fund tax levy. Amends ORS 369.290. Eff. 1 Jul 67. (S 343)

County roads, contractor's performance bond c.10 A

Reduces amount of performance bond required of contractors on county road projects to not less than 50 percent of contract price. Amends ORS 368.235. (H 1062)

emergency expenditures c.270 A

Authorizes counties to expend available county funds, during disaster emergencies, to provide roadways for public use when county roads are closed for repairs. Adds to ORS chapter 368. (S 323)

liability for defects c.500 A

Limits recovery of damages resulting from defective county roads to situations where county has, or should have had, sufficient notice to remedy defective condition. Increases amount recoverable from \$2,000 to \$10,000. Repeals ORS 368.935. (S 247)

limited access c.364 A

Extends right to all counties to establish limited access highways on county roads designated as throughways. Amends ORS 374.420, 374.425, 374.430. (H 1067)

Highway lighting districts, assessments A/SP. c.21

Permits highway lighting districts to levy assessments on any reasonable basis, subject to limit of \$1 per front foot. Amends ORS 372.170. (S 51)

formation, meetings c.05 A/SP.

Permits county court, after hearing on petition to form highway lighting district, to deny petition if remonstrances are filed or adjust boundaries and grant petition. Requires district commissioners to meet annually rather than quarterly. Amends ORS 372.090, 372.110, 372.220. (S 52)

Public roads, vacating A c.25

Provides procedure for vacating public roads, other than county roads or state highways, outside cities. Amends ORS 271.010. (H 1066)

Road assessment districts, withdrawal of annexed areas c.347 A

Provides procedure for withdrawal of property from road assessment district when property annexed to city which assumes duty of maintaining roads. Adds to ORS 371.405 to 471.535. Eff. 10 May 65. (S 325)

Special road districts, annexation, formation, tax levies c.498 A

Provides for adding land to special road district upon petition of landowners, with denial of petition if 50 percent of owners object. Revises procedure for formation of district. Authorizes tax levy prior to establishment of tax base. Permits improvements to any noncounty road. Amends sections in and adds to ORS 371.305 to 371.360. Eff. 22 May 65. (S 207)

State highways, acquisition of land to exchange with railroads c.383 A

Changes authority of State Highway Commission to acquire land to exchange for railroad right of way to permit acquisition of such land "within a reasonable distance" rather than "adjacent." Amends ORS 366.335. (S 19)

acquisition of land to exchange with utilities c.382 A

Authorizes State Highway Commission, if property of utility is

State highways, acquisition of land to exchange with utilities (cont.)

required for highway, to obtain other nearby property and exchange for utility's land. Defines "real property" and "utility." Adds to ORS chapter 366. Eff. 13 May 65. (S 18)

acquisition of right of way, relocation of facilities VETOED A/SP.

Requires State Highway Commission to pay expenses of relocating facilities of water, sanitary and irrigation districts, or sanitary authority in highway right of way. Vetoes by Governor; will be reconsidered by next legislative session. (S 178)

financial assistance to persons displaced c.222 A

Permits certain financial assistance to persons displaced when property acquired by State Highway Commission and no federal funds available or used for such assistance. Amends ORS 366.324. Eff. 20 Apr 65. (H 1058)

Extends apprenticeship law to

Implies consent to breath test for alcoholic content of blood, if person on highway is arrested for driving while under influence of intoxicating liquor. Directs State Board of Health to test equipment, establish techniques of testing and provide training for and issue permits to persons who make tests. Repeals ORS 483.630. Adds to ORS chapter 483. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (H 1111)

Declares outdoor recreation policy for Oregon. (H 1275)

PUBLIC WELFARE

Blind, aid, eligibility and need A/SP. c.40

Authorizes State Public Welfare Commission to disregard amounts of income and resources of applicant or recipient within limits permitted or required by federal laws and rules. Amends ORS 412.025. Eff. 4 Mar 65. (H 1121)

aid, examination A c.94

Authorizes examination by Oregon licensed optometrist or by an ophthalmologist or optometrist licensed in another state or territory having qualifications substantially similar to those of Oregon. Amends ORS 412.005. Eff. 16 Mar 65. (H 1281)

aid, minimum A c.468

Increases minimum aid to blind from \$85 to \$98 per month. Appropriates \$128,044 to State Public Welfare Commission for such aid. Amends ORS 412.055. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (H 1330)

aid, students A c.469

Increases annual grants-in-aid to blind students to \$1,250 for undergraduate and to \$1,500 for graduate student; limits use to supplying readers' services. Increases eligibility period to period required for degree. Includes community college students as eligible to receive grants. Appropriates \$7,245 and increases limitation of Commission for Blind by \$15,750 to carry out Act. Amends ORS 346.060. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (H 1331)

Commission for the, members A c.522

Removes from membership on Commission for the Blind members of State Board of Education who were erroneously added by c. 100, OL 65. Amends ORS 346.130. Eff. 22 May 65. (S 419)

Blind, refusal of permit for vending stands in public buildings A/SP. c.471

Requires head of department or agency, charged with maintenance of public building, to give written explanation for refusing to permit establishment of vending stand under auspices of Commission for the Blind on premises if any stand is established. Requires written explanation for refusing offer from commission when vending stand license or permit is issued or renewed. Amends ORS 346.530, 346.540. (H 1483)

Dependent children, aid, eligibility A c.538

Deletes provision requiring State Public Welfare Commission to consider parents' unemployment compensation as family resource. Eff. 25 May 65. (H 1534)

aid, eligibility and need N/SP. c.41

Authorizes State Public Welfare Commission to disregard amounts of income and resources of applicant or recipient within limits permitted or required by federal laws and rules. Amends ORS 418.045. Eff. 4 Mar 65. (H 1122)

Disabled, aid, eligibility and need A/SP. c.42

Authorizes State Public Welfare Commission to disregard amounts of income and resources of applicant or recipient within limits permitted or required by federal laws and rules. Amends ORS 412.530. Eff. 4 Mar 65. (H 1123)

aid, examination A c.93

Authorizes examination of applicant by physician licensed in another state or territory who has qualifications substantially similar to those required by Oregon. Amends ORS 412.540. Eff. 16 Mar 65. (H 1280)

Juveniles, commitment to county institution A c.567

Authorizes care and custody of children to be committed by juvenile court to county in lieu of MacLaren or Hillcrest. Provides reimbursement to county equal to 25% of costs per child. Limits program to Douglas County, and appropriates \$20,000 to Board of Control for reimbursement and

Juveniles, commitment to county institution (cont.)

other costs, during 1965-67 biennium. Amends ORS 418.020, 418.025. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (S 152)

Liquor revenues, use for welfare A c.141

Permits governing body of county to use revenues from liquor privilege tax to meet county's 30 percent share of state-county public welfare program cost. Amends ORS 473.210. Eff. 2 Apr 65. (H 1229)

Medical care A c.556

Transfers medical care and services from existing public assistance programs to combined medical assistance program for needy persons. Specifies sections effective 1 Jul 65, 1 Jan 66, and 1 Jul 66, but not operative until federal funds are available. Amends sections in and adds to ORS chapters 411, 412, 413. Repeals sections in ORS chapter 413. (H 1862)

Old-age assistance, eligibility and need A/SP. c.43

Authorizes State Public Welfare Commission to disregard amounts of income and resources of applicant or recipient within limits permitted or required by federal laws and rules. Amends ORS 413.120. Eff. 4 Mar 65. (H 1124)

Public assistance, application for EXCLUDED c.300

Eliminates requirement that application for public assistance be by sworn statement. Amends ORS 411.650. Eff. 4 May 65. (H 1282)

Work relief programs A c.291

Broadens work relief programs by authorizing agencies of federal or state government, towns, public corporations or political subdivisions in state to participate as well as cities and counties. Amends ORS 411.855, 411.860, 418.095, 657.067, 657.140. Eff. 4 May 65. (H 1110)

Cigarette tax, proposal A c.525

personal, repeal of ORS chapter 315 A c.26

personal, Uniform Division of Income For Tax Purposes Act A c.152

Inheritance and gift taxes, annual gift tax exclusions, future interests c.357 A

Specifies that, for purposes of gift tax annual exclusions after 31 Dec 65, gifts to minor donees constitute present, not future, interests, if donees may obtain benefits of gifts before reaching 21 and remainders of gifts pass to donees on reaching 21 or, if donees die before 21, pass to their estates or under their exercise of powers of appointment. powers of appointment, deductions c.470 A

Redefines, for inheritance tax purposes after 1 Jul 66, powers of appointment and effect thereof on taxability of property passing subject to such powers. Limits deduction for last illness expenses in unprobated estates to those owing at date of death. Amends ORS 118.010, 118.070. (H 1452)

Property tax, assessment, boundary changes c.411 A

Property tax, assessment, farm land A/SP c.622

Directs county assessors and State Tax Commission to ascertain that comparable sales, used to value agricultural lands, represent sales for bona fide agricultural use. (H 1620)

assessment, motor vehicles and boats, cancellation A c.86

Requires proof of registration of motor vehicles and boats to be submitted prior to May 15 to obtain cancellation of assessment of such vehicle or boat, instead of later deadlines. Amends ORS 481.270 and 488.732. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (S 71)

assessment and collection, distribution to taxing units A/SP c.492

Changes distribution formula for optional gross earnings tax of rural telephone exchanges. Revises provisions, applicable in counties of over 80,000, by which tax distributions are made on a percentage ratio. Amends ORS 308.725, 311.390. Adds to ORS chapter 311. Applies to 1965-66 and subsequent assessments and tax rolls. (S 122)

assessment and collection, procedure A c.344

Revises procedures for assessment and collection of ad valorem taxes. Amends sections in ORS chapters 204, 305, 308, 311, 312. Repeals sections in ORS chapters 308, 311. Eff. 1 Jan 66. (S 297)

centrally assessed air transportation N c.175

Revises provisions on assessment of property used in air transportation to reflect new federal certification procedures. Amends ORS 308.515. (H 1133)

inventories, reduction c.604 A

Declares intent of state to reduce inventory taxes by stated percentages each year beginning in 1966. Appropriates \$2 million for fiscal year beginning July 1, 1966, for apportionment among counties and taxing districts in proportion to inventory tax assessments. Changes dates for quarterly payment of forest products harvest tax to last day of October, January, April and July. Amends ORS 321.045. (S 259)

harvest report c.412

Changes provisions requiring report of timber harvested to conform to terminology used in 1961 timber tax legislation, and to require report of harvest of "reproduction" timber. Amends ORS 321.955. (H 1172)

nonqualifying use of land c.191

Imposes additional taxes plus interest on land assessed under Western Oregon ad valorem tax if assessor finds that use of land no longer qualifies it for special treatment. Amends ORS 321.620. (H 1641)

Western Oregon Small Tract classifications c.371

Extends from August 9, 1965, to August 9, 1966, time to apply for classification under Western Oregon Small Tract Optional Tax Act. Amends ORS 321.735, 321.750. (H 1466)

Department of Employment,
special administrative fund c.359

Establishes Department of Employment Special Administrative Fund to pay costs of audit by Secretary of State and other authorized expenses. Adds to and amends sections in ORS chapter 657. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (H 1485)

Musicians, leader of group
responsible for taxes c.392

Bars collection of unpaid unemployment insurance taxes due on work performed before July 1, 1963, by owner-operators of logging trucks. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (S 213)

Benefit claims, hearing and
appeal procedure A c.210

Revises hearing procedures on benefit claims, charges to employer accounts and tax rate matters, and provides for judicial review thereof. Amends ORS 657.265 to 657.275, 657.290, 657.485. Eff. 1 Jul 65. (S 252)

Benefits, eligibility c.213

Provides that disqualification for those who marry or accompany spouse attaches if they "leave" work, and not only if they "re-sign." Amends ORS 657.160. (S 283)

Covered employment, exclusion,
securities salesmen c.131

Excludes services of securities salesman or agent from coverage to extent he is compensated by commission. Amends ORS 657.085. (H 1044)

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✓ WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

Experience rating c.546

Authorizes employer to reduce contribution 25 percent if not entitled to experience rating. Limits any annual change in experience rating. Makes employer eligible who has been subject to law for six months and has paid contributions of \$750 or more. Authorizes application of regular claim chargeability in fatal and permanent total disability claims if third party recovery is effected. Amends ORS 656.510, 656.514, 656.516. Effective 1 Jul 65, and repeals such sections when sec. 95, c.285, OL 1965 ("Three-way law") becomes operative. (H 1780)

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"Three-way" bill c.285

Revises workmen's compensation law to impose virtually universal coverage, but permits employer to obtain state or private insurance or to qualify as self-insurer. Increases benefits. Changes laws governing claims and appeals, administration and financing. Replaces Industrial Accident Commission with Workmen's Compensation Board and State Compensation Department. Amends and repeals numerous sections in ORS chapter 656 and others. Becomes fully operative on January 1, 1966. (H 1001)

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Fire Marshal, duties c.417

HB 1142
Modifies functions and duties of State Fire Marshal. Prohibits interference with fire equipment or firefighters. Establishes regulations for fire safety in new buildings and places of public assembly. Modifies definition of, and regulates sale and use of fireworks. Modifies regulations concerning inspection and handling fees for LP gas; exempts governmental units from LP gas installation regulations. Eff. 15 Jun. 67.

Governor, emergency powers

c.480
HB 1499
Provides emergency powers for Governor to manage resources of state in event of an emergency such as actual attack by a foreign nation. Provides for coordination with Federal Government and other states. Eff. 30 Jun. 67.

state executive residence c.615

SB 556
Authorizes Capitol Planning Commission to accept gifts for construction of state executive residence. Authorizes Department of General Services to cause construction of residence when moneys received by gift are determined adequate.

Health, State Board, deputy state health officers, appointment c.363

HB 1049
Authorizes State Health Officer to appoint non-permanent deputy state health officers to perform duties directed by the State Health Officer. Prohibits deputies from serving on any board or commission of which the State Health Officer is required by law to be a voting member.

Intergovernmental Coordinator c.165

SB 72
Requires Governor to appoint an Intergovernmental Coordinator to assist in obtaining, and coordinating use of, federal aid by state and local governments.

Notaries public c.541

HB 1454
Simplifies procedure for appointment of notaries public. Permits use of rubber stamps. Revises other provisions of notarial laws to reflect 1961 enactment of Uniform Commercial Code. Modifies penalties.

Office space, Capitol c.2

HB 1001
Deletes requirement that Secretary of Board of Control, Clerk of State Land Board, Director of Veterans' Affairs and Workmen's Compensation Board maintain offices in the Capitol. Eff. 24 Jan. 67.

Retirement, public employes, Airport Police, Port of Portland c.160

HB 1477
Adds Airport Police of Port of Portland to definition of police officers under PERS.

public employes, circuit court reporters c.229

SB 186
Makes circuit court reporters county employes for the purposes of PERS or county retirement plan. Eff. 4 May 67.

public employes, legislature employment of retired persons c.214

SB 545
Authorizes employment by legislature of persons who have reached compulsory retirement age under PERS. Prohibits contributions to retirement fund by or on behalf of persons so employed, and payment of retirement benefits during such employment. Eff. 3 May 67.

public employes, National Guard employes c.108

SB 432
Redefines legislative intent in establishing effective date for bringing Oregon National Guard employes under PERS. Eff. 3 Apr. 67.

public employes, revision c.622

HB 1264
Modifies benefits and contributions under Public Employes' Retirement Act. Sets rate of employe's contribution as percentage of monthly pay. Increases allowable voluntary additional contribution by policemen and firemen. Provides for retirement
