JOINT ASSEMBLY IN THE HOUSE

(In the Senate)

PRESIDENT:

"The Desk Staff and members of the Senate will assemble in the center aisle and be assisted by the Sergeant at Arms to form a column of two's to march to the House."

(Formation in Senate)

Order for column is:

1. Sgt. at Arms & Secy. of Senate
2. President & President Pro Tempore
3. Senators
4. Desk Staff

Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of the Senate lead the group in the procession to the House. Column halts as it arrives at the center entrance of the House. The center doors may or may not be open. If not open, Senate Sgt. at Arms raps on the door and announces to House Sgt. at Arms that the Senate has arrived.

JOINT ASSEMBLY IN THE HOUSE

(In the House)

House Sgt. at Arms will be at the center doors. He greets the Senate and addresses the Speaker.

House Sgt. at Arms:

"I have the honor to announce that the Senate has arrived."

Speaker:

"The Sergeant at Arms will admit the members of the Senate and staff."

House Sgt. at Arms stands by the center doors and the Secretary of the Senate, Senate Sgt. at Arms and Senators walk down the center aisle in a column of twos, halting at the half-way point.

Speaker:

"The Sergeant at Arms of the House will escort the President of the Senate to the Rostrum."

Note: President is escorted to the steps of the Rostrum. The column remains in place while the President is being escorted to the Rostrum.

Speaker:

(Greets the President, tenders the gavel. The President then presides.)

President:

"The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate will seat the Senate members and staff."

Senate Sgt. at Arms proceeds to Rostrum, faces the Senators and directs them left and right as the Senate members, starting with the pair at the end of the line, proceed down the center aisle filing off by two's with the right column turning right and the left column turning left. (Chairs are to be provided for Senators in front of the first row of House members' desks.)

Senate Secretary takes a seat on the lower level of the Rostrum next to the House Chief Clerk.

Senate Sgt. at Arms then takes a position at the desk of the House Sgt. at Arms.

Desk staff will proceed to the north aisle -- chairs will be provided.

1 GAVEL

President:

"This Joint Assembly will come to order."

1 GAVEL

President:

"The Secretary of the Senate will call the roll of the Senate."

(Roll Call)

President:

"The Clerk will call the roll of the House."

(Roll Call)

President:

"Mr. Speaker, distinguished guests, and members of this Joint Assembly: To expedite procedure and if there is no objection, the Committee to escort Governor Atiyeh will be named by the Chair without the formality of a motion."

1 GAVEL

President:

"The Chair appoints Representatives Campbell and B. Roberts and Senators Meeker and Wyers to serve as a committee to escort the Honorable Victor Atiyeh, Governor of the State of Oregon, within the Bar of the House."

President:

"Please be at ease until the Governor arrives."

(Governor will be waiting in Ceremonial Office.)

(The Committee enters the House door with the Governor, takes five steps and stops...)

President:

"The Chair recognizes Representative Campbell."

Rep. Campbell:

"Mr. President, I have the honor to present the Honorable Victor Atiyeh, Governor of Oregon."

President:

"You will escort Governor Atiyeh to the Rostrum."

3 GAVELS

(After Governor Atiyeh is ushered to his seat on the Rostrum...)

1 GAVEL

President:

Presents the Honorable Victor Atiyeh, Governor of Oregon, to deliver his Message to the Joint Assembly.

(After Governor's Message)

President:

(Expresses "thanks" to Governor)

President:

"Senators Meeker and Wyers and Representatives Campbell and B. Roberts will escort Governor Atiyeh from the House."

3 GAVELS

(After Governor Atiyeh has left the chamber...)

President:

"The Senate will reconvene immediately in the Senate Chamber. This Joint Assembly is declared adjourned."

1 GAVEL

(President hands gavel to Speaker)

Speaker:

Assumes gavel immediately. If audience is seated, rap gavel 3 times to rise, then say:

"The House Sergeant at Arms will escort the President of the Senate, members and officers of the Senate from the Chamber."

(When last person has cleared the door...)

1 GAVEL

Speaker:

Makes announcements relative to the House.

(House recess until 1:30 p.m.)
