### What is A. S. H.?

ASH is private enterprise providing quality, low cost housing to students of Pacific University. It consists of 100 apartment units plus a laundry, storage and recreation facility, built in 1969.

### Who can live in A. S. H.?

Any student enrolled at Pacific University who qualifies to live off campus.

### What are the features of the apartments?

- \* All two bedroom
- \* Wall to wall carpeting
- \* Color coordinated ranges, refrigerators, hoods
- \* Drapes and Carpets
- \* Water and garbage free
- \* Covered patio-porches
- \* Rental furniture available
- \* Courtyards and playgrounds
- \* A complex designed for students and producing a student community

### What does it cost to live in A. S. H.?

Married students - \$89.50 per month  
2 Single students - \$45.00 per month each  
3 Single students - \$40.00 per month each

Only \$25.00 cleaning deposit  
Pets allowed by permission

### What are the special policies of A. S. H.?

- \* Non-profit. Surplus, if any, will be re-distributed to tenants
- \* Rent-rates will not increase for each individual tenant during entire tenure at Pacific.  
Example: A freshman in pre-optometry could live in ASH for all 6 years without a raise in his rate
