Dear Governor Atiyeh:

The Oregon Department of Transportation, upon the recommendation of the Historic Columbia River Highway Advisory Committee, will be nominating the Historic Columbia River Highway as a National Historic Landmark. We request a letter from you supporting this action. Enclosed is a draft letter for your consideration.

ODOT and the HCRH AC have devoted much of the last year to documenting the integrity and significance of the HCRH. The NHL nomination is over 100 pages long, not including illustrations, photos and maps. I believe that this document supports the conclusion that the HCRH possesses the high significance and integrity needed for NHL status.

Your original submittal of the Highway requested its designation as a National Historic Landmark. The National Park Service added the HCRH as a district listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
