Oregon's trade delegation in the middle east has inaugurated an new U.S. pavillion at the Cario International Trade Fair.

And as Mike Donahue reports, the Oregonians discovered that in Egypt that the value of a dollar depends on what you are trying to buy.

In size the fair resembles a home show at the Multnomah County Expo Center. Only exhibitors there never count 100,000 visitors a day.

Each Eqyptian paid 30 piasters or about 25 cents admission (mumble) had been charged 10 pounds or about 15 dollars to attend the shows opening.

That is just one of the inconsistancies in Eqypt's so called economy of surprises. Attempting to eliminate the black market, President Mobarick has authorized 5 different exchange rates.

As an incentive to buy local you can get up to 115 piasters per dollar, while to pay your American hotel bill, it might as few as 40 piasters for that same dollar.

U.S. firms doing business here have also been surprised by Egyptian (mumble). Market surveyors thought floor wax was an untouchable product in a country where clean is a dirty word.

Today, Johnson's wax cannot keep enough stock in its Cairo warehouse to meet the demands.

Farm implements are selling too as the government reclaims vast desert areas for agriculture irrigated by the Nile.
