EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 67-24

PROCLAMATION CALLING A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

There is a compelling need for property tax relief which can be accomplished only by the Legislative Assembly, and it now appears that revenues for the current biennium will not be as great as were estimated at the Regular Session of the 54th Legislative Assembly, and it is desirable that the Legislative Assembly have an opportunity to make appropriate revisions.

THEREFORE, I, TOM McCALL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF OREGON, find that an extraordinary occasion exists, and I do, by this proclamation, pursuant to Article V, Section 12, of the Oregon Constitution, call the 54th Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon to convene in Special Session on Monday, October 30, 1967, at 10:00 a.m.

Given over my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Oregon at the Capital in Salem this 8th day of September, A.D., 1967.
