You will be contacted within the next few days by a member of the Steering Committee. It would be helpful if by that time you will have a list of your members who are willing to give time and energy for this campaign, and a commitment from your union to contribute financial support.

The Labor Movement in Oregon must take a leadership role in the State. It must be concerned with the needs of the people of Oregon, the needs of its membership, and concerned with supporting responsible political leaders.

INSTRUCTIONS: Enclosed are a cover page and two (2) petitions. Please sign this petition, have some friends sign it, and then return it to:

Only registered voters can sign. Each petition must be filled out by the County. After you have obtained signatures, at the bottom of the petition fill in your name and address under Circulator's Affidavit. Don't wat on this!! I am sure you have a few friends that would be more than willing to sign. There are only 20 signature lines on each petition. It won't take you more than a day to get 20 signatures. Be sure and send in the petition as soon as it is completed. Deadline for submission of petitions is September 20 - return petitions, even if they have only a few signatures by September 20.

Note: Have signers from same county on each petition. If there are signatures of persons from more than one county on a petition, that petition will be voided.

INSTRUCTIONS

FOR CIRCULATORS

- -Only electors may sign a petition.
- -Do not use ditto marks.
- -It is advisable to use a pen or indelible pencil for signing petitions.
- -Only one circulator may collect signatures on any one sheet of a petition.
- —All signers on any one sheet of a petition should be electors of the same county.
- —The signature sheet affidavit must be completed for each sheet by the circulator of that sheet.
- —It is unlawful for a person circulating a petition to knowingly make any false statement to any person who signs it or requests information about it.
- —It is unlawful to circulate or file a petition knowing it to contain a false signature.
- —It is unlawful to give or receive any money for securing signatures of electors on a petition.

FOR SIGNERS

- -Only electors may sign a petition.
- -Do not use ditto marks.
- —Sign your full name, as you did when you registered, and fill in your residence address and precinct in the spaces provided.
- —If your signature is difficult to read, print your name clearly in the space provided.
- —It is unlawful to sign any person's name other than your own. Do not sign another person's name under any circumstances.
- —A woman should sign her own name, not her husband's or her husband's initials; for example, "Mary A. Jones," not "Mrs. John A. Jones."
- -It is unlawful to sign a petition more than once.
- —It is unlawful for a person to knowingly sign a petition when not qualified to sign it.
