Dear Senator Winters,

I am writing to ask your help for a project that is very dear to my heart. Located in Willson Park, the grounds adjacent to the State Capitol, are segments of Corinthian columns that originally were part of those that graced the west and east entrance porticos of Oregon's first statehouse. These columns were found during 1980 in Mill Creek, near the Governor's residence, and on the State 4-H property. They were salvaged and returned to their original location for the interest of historical preservation.

My wife, Dolores, and I promoted the idea of preserving the column segments as a piece of Oregon's history. Mrs. Atiyeh worked with the Oregon Historical Properties Committee, Department of General Services' employees, and personnel and inmates from the Oregon State Penitentiary to design and construct a display of the segments. In addition, many citizens donated time, talent and materials to this project so that Oregonians and visitors could enjoy a part of Oregon State Government history.

The marble monument and dedication plaque, originally installed on February 12, 1981, have weathered over the years to the point where the text on the plaque is nearly illegible. It is Mrs. Atiyeh's and my desire to raise funds to repair the monument and replace the plaque. The Department of Administrative Services will cover the repair cost of the marble monument. The cost for a new brass plaque is approximately \$910.
