Agencies are grouped by program similarity to show general administrative and budgetary relationships without regard to agency size, title, or agency head, except for elective offices.

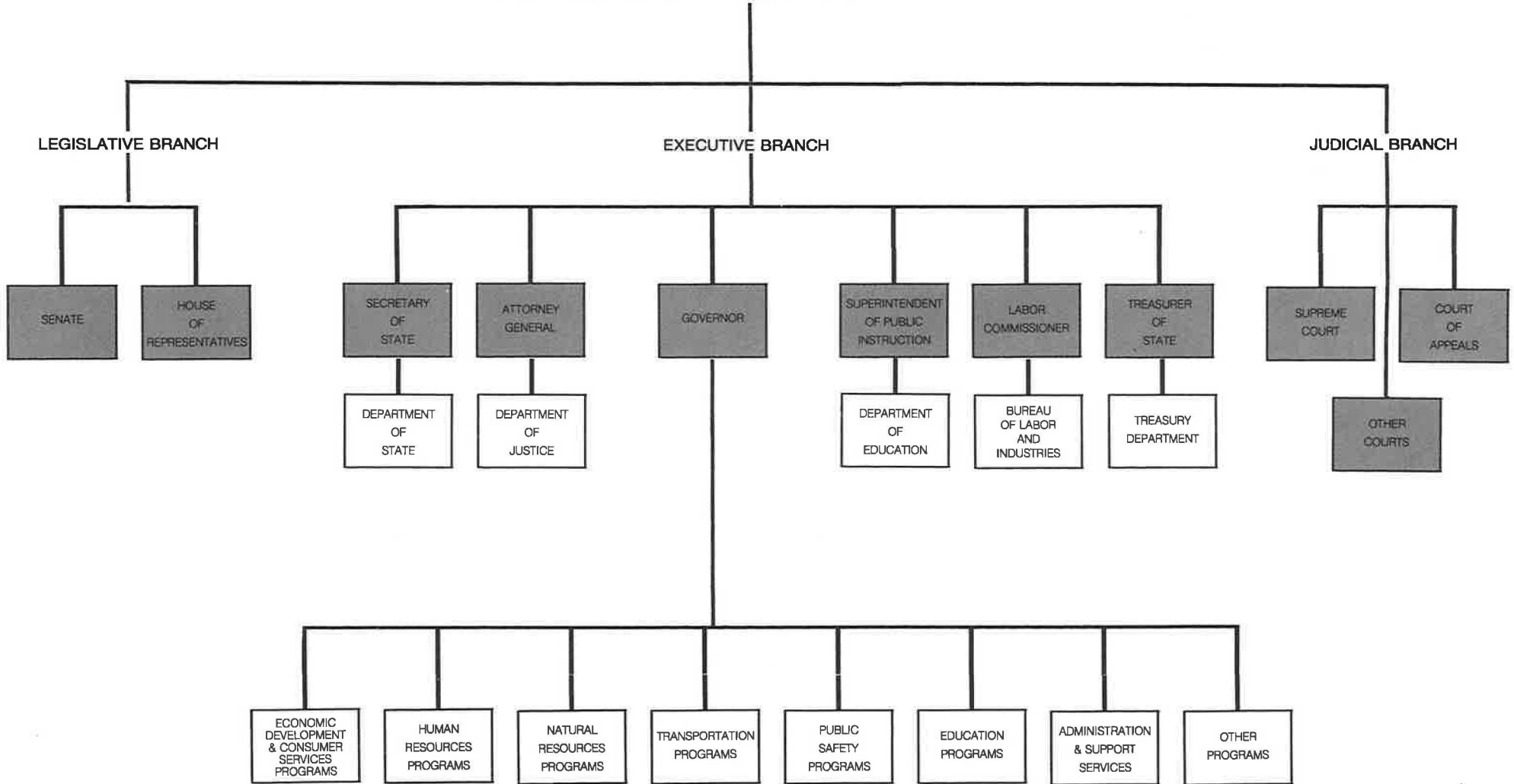

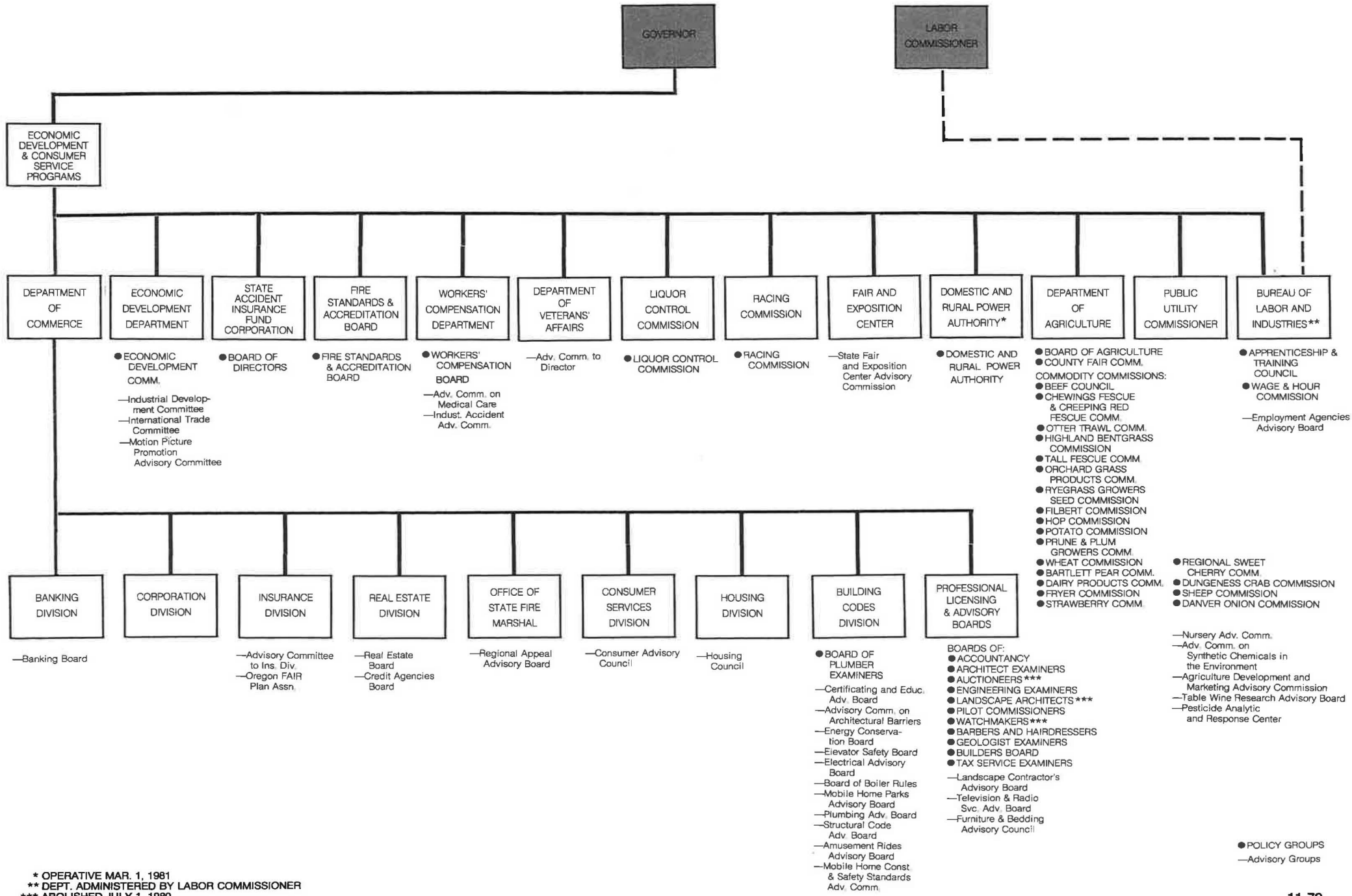

SHADING DEPICTS ELECTIVE OFFICES

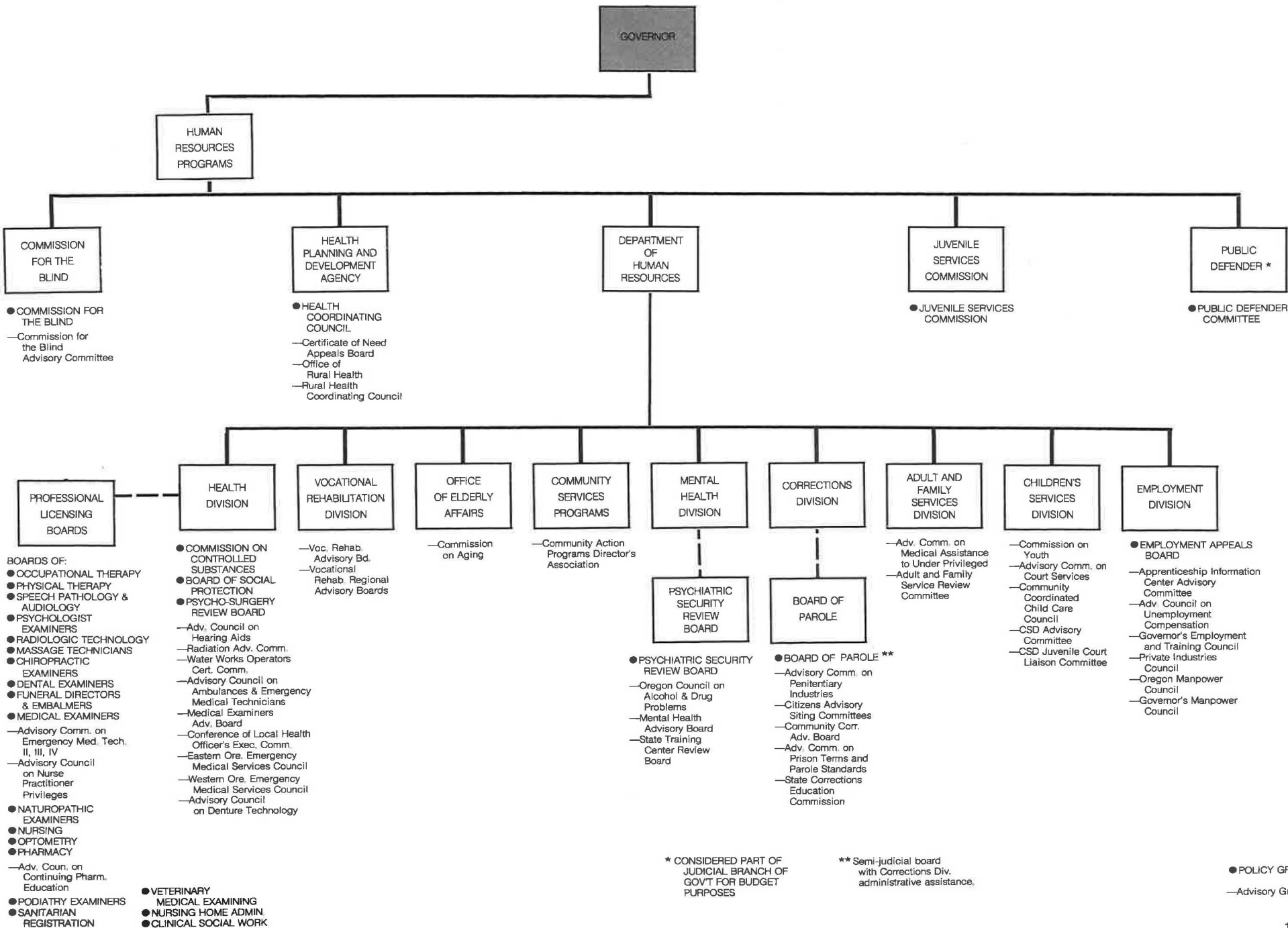

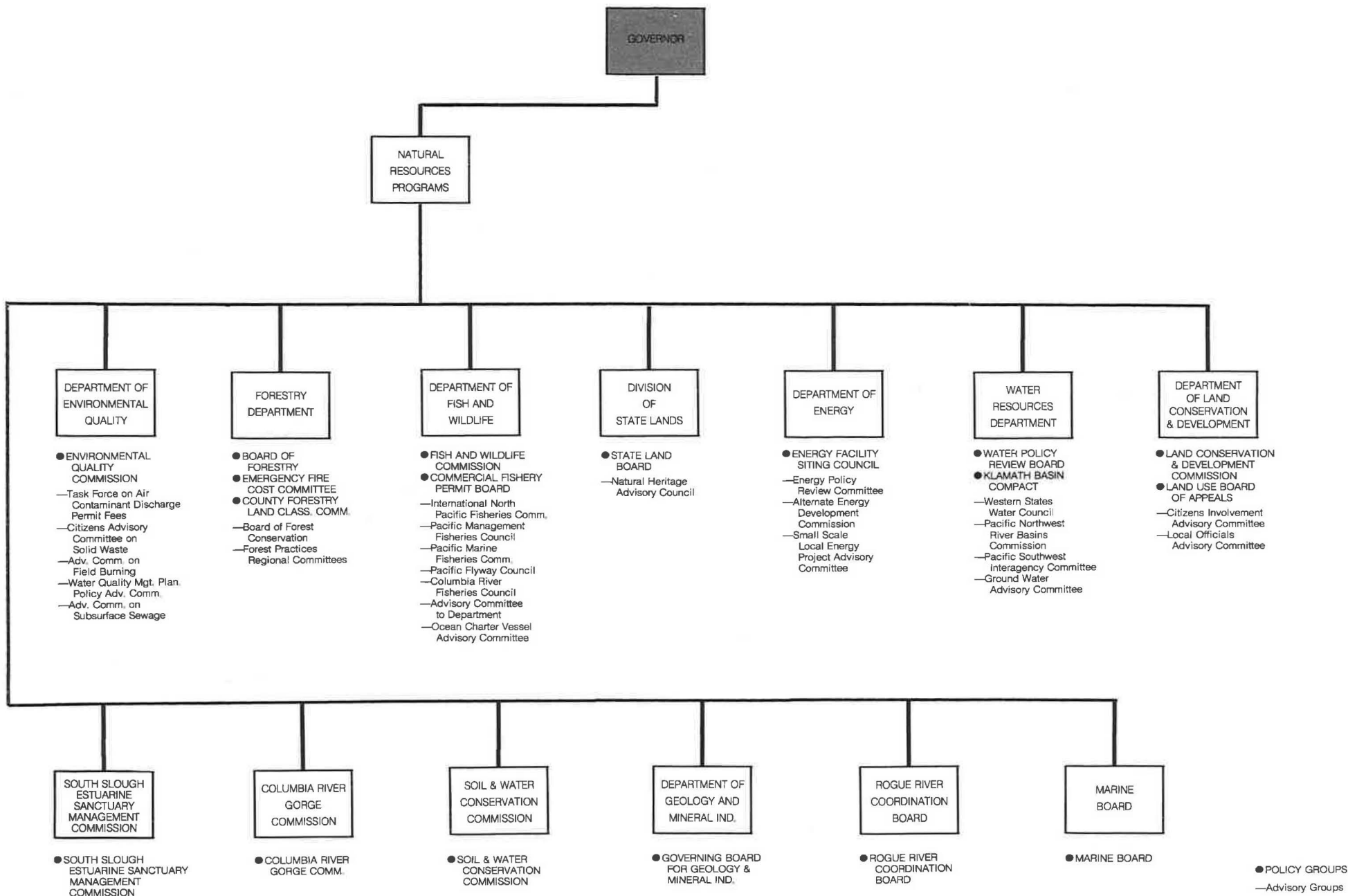

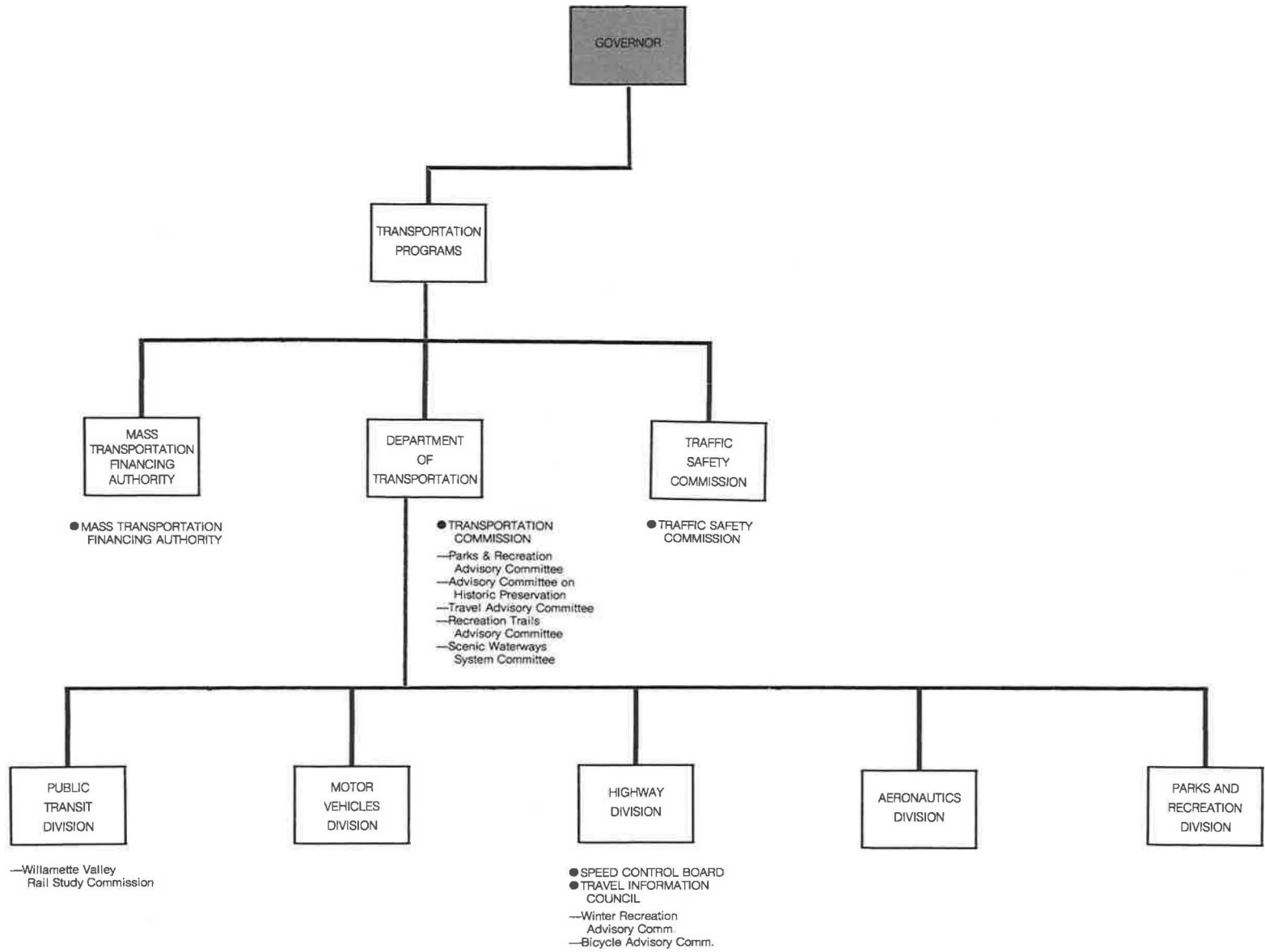

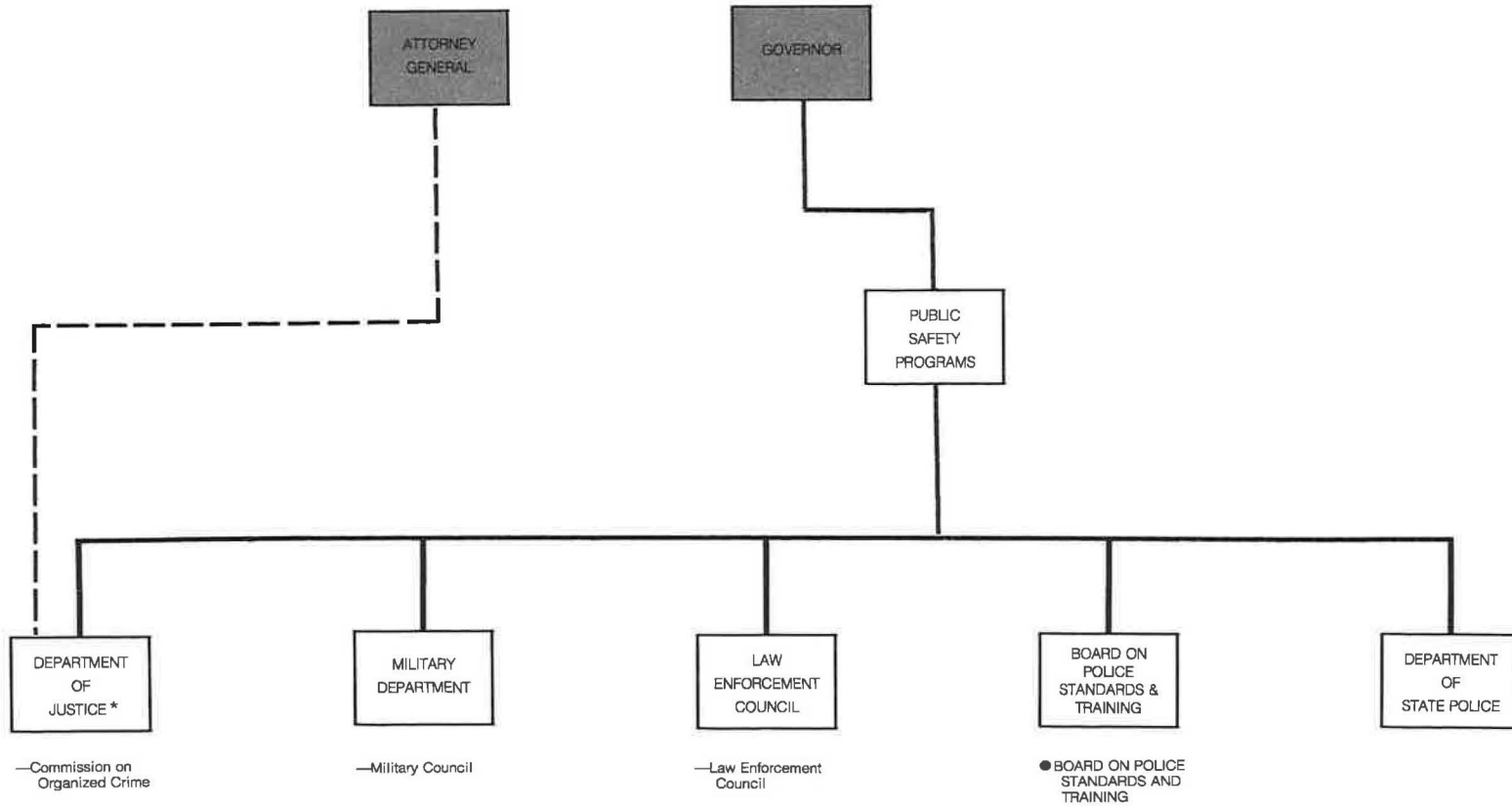


# TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

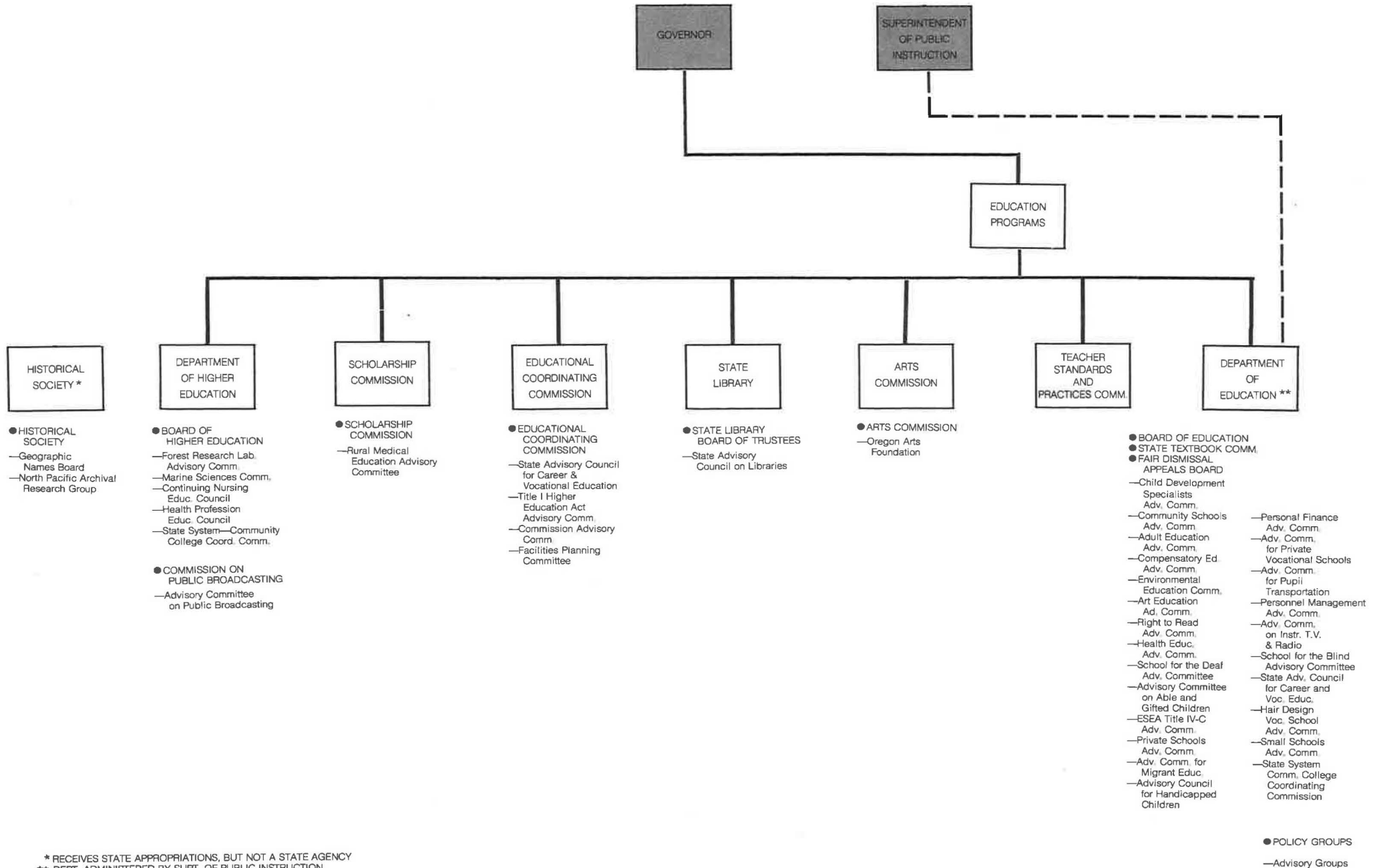

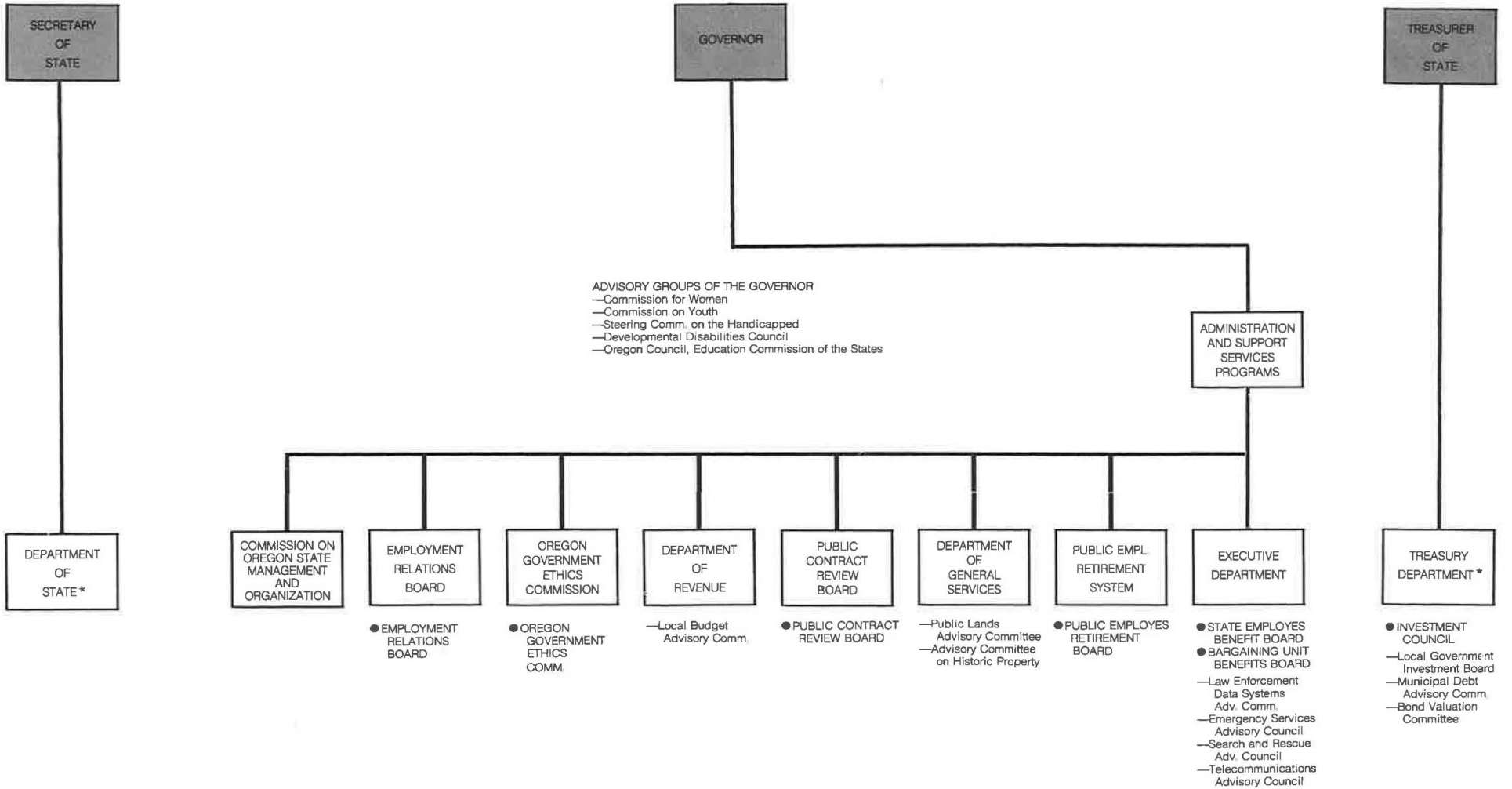

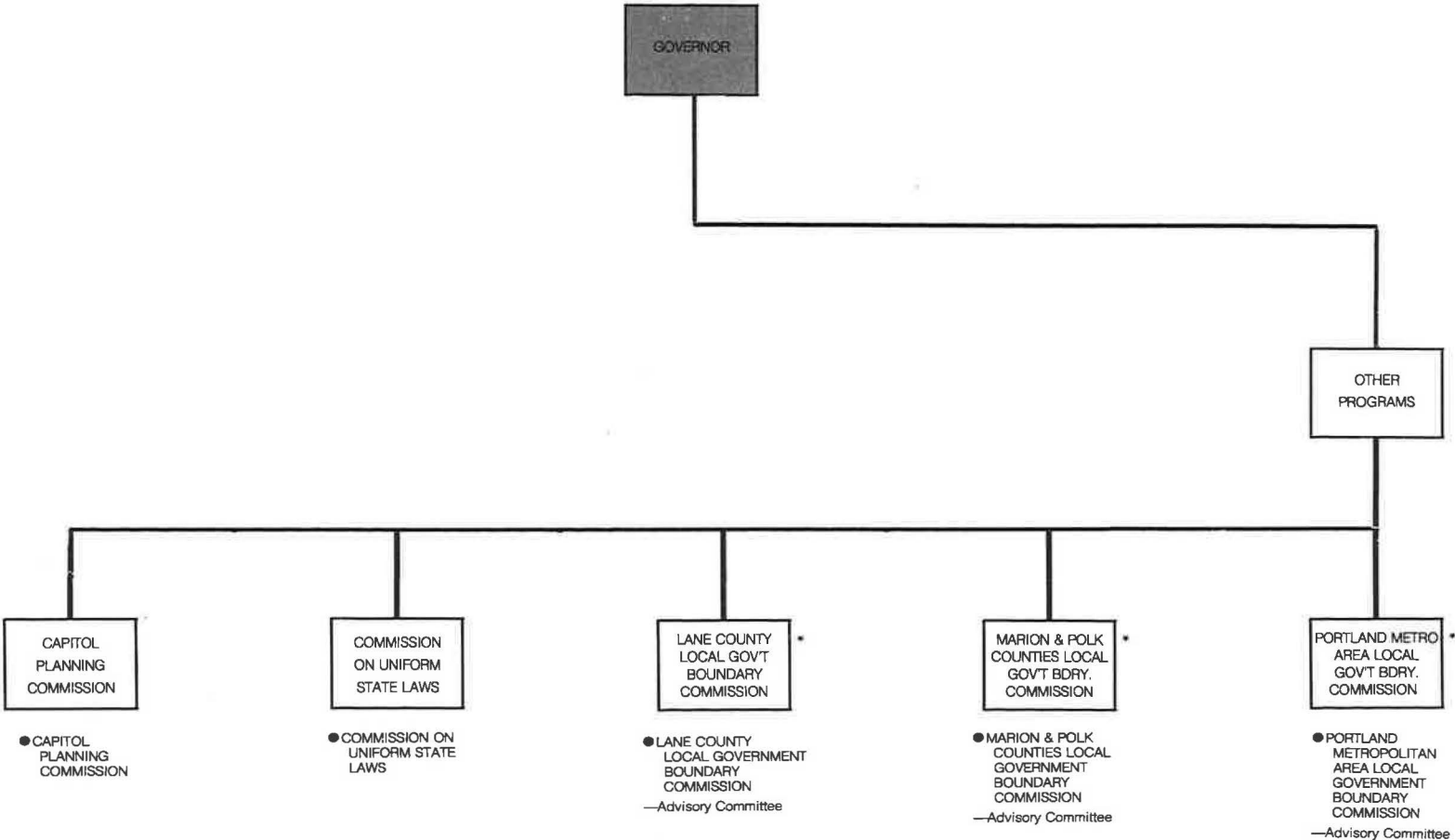
