These ORGANIZATION CHARTS are revised to include action of the 60th Legislative Assembly.


Agencies are grouped by program similarity to show general administrative and budgetary relationships without regard to agency size, title, or agency head, except for elective offices.

Understanding of the "division of powers" is assumed. Therefore, the direction and control exercised by the Legislative and Judicial Branches on Executive Branch agencies is not illustrated.

While this is a serious portrayal of the current organization of Oregon state government, a view into the past is also presented on the last of these sheets. Some may be intrigued with the comparison.








